Rules and Scoring

Group members can enter bracket(s) picking the winners of the 2026 Men's national college basketball tournament. Members predict the winners of tournament games from the field of 64 teams through the championship.

Bracket Entry

Brackets can be entered online starting Sunday, March 15th at 8:00pm PST.

Entries are accepted online until **Thursday, March 19th at 9:17am PST**.

After this time, only the group owner can enter late brackets. Consult the group owner for their policy on late submissions.

Scoring

Brackets are scored as follows, for each correct pick:

Points are awarded based on the round number:

Round 1:	2
Round 2:	4
Round 3:	8
Round 4:	16
Semifinals:	32
Championship:	64

Then multiply by *Seed number if result is upset*

Then add *Bonus points per round (below)* for the first round only.

Bonus points per round:

Round 1:	2
Round 2:	4
Round 3:	8
Round 4:	16
Semifinals:	32
Championship:	64

Add 50 extra points for correctly picking all four regional champions.

Add 20 extra points for correctly picking all four first round 5-12 games.

Add 40 extra points for correctly picking all four first round 6-11 games.

Add 60 extra points for correctly picking all four first round 7-10 games.

Add 20 extra points for correctly picking all four first round 8-9 games.

The first tiebreaker is *Riskiest upset picks*.

The second tiebreaker is *Most games correct*.

The third tiebreaker is *Total points in championship game*.

Any further ties are left as ties in the standings.
